**REGULATION
ON INTERNATIONAL CHESS COMPETITION, DEVOTED TO THE
MEMORY OF GENNADIY PUSHKARYOV**

1. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- Promotion of the healthy life-style among deaf chess players;
- Strengthening friendly sports ties between countries;
- Participation in this competition contributes to the following objectives:
 - (1) Making chess popular among deaf people;
 - (2) Rehabilitation of deaf people through physical culture and sports, including chess as an intellectual sports event;
 - (3) Pay the tribute to the memory of G. Pushkaryov, an outstanding coach and person.

2. TIME AND VENUE

International chess competition, devoted to the memory of Gennadiy Pushkaryov shall be conducted on 26-27 November 2016 in Almaty (Kazakhstan). The arrival date – 25 November 2016, departure date – 28 November 2016.

3. MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPETITION

General management of preparation and running the competition shall be effected by the referee board approved by Kazakhstan Chess Federation.

4. PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATIONS

The event is an individual competition. The participants are the invited sportsmen included in the list from Kazakhstan (12), Uzbekistan (1), Kyrgyzstan (1), Germany (1), Ukraine (2), England (2), Georgia (1).

**5. PARTICIPANTS OF THE COMPETITION AND
ADMISSION RULES**

The sportsmen – hearing impaired persons included into the invitee list shall take part in the completion, if the level of their hearing loss is not less than 55 dB for the better hearing ear (the average frequency at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hz ICO according to standards of 1964).

The sportsmen who have passed the special medical examination and obtained the permit of a doctor, affirmed by a signature and a seal of a doctor or a sports medical centre, may be admitted to the competition.

During the competition a participating sportsman may not use personal sound amplifying equipment or a hearing aid, as well as a mobile phone.

6. COMPETITION REGULATIONS

The competition shall be conducted under a Swiss system – 7 rounds, 25 minutes for each player. The drawing and start of the competition on 26 November 2016 at 10.00 – 4 rounds. On 27 November 2016 at 10.00 – 3 rounds. Competition venue – Muratbayev Street, Kazakh Deaf Society building, 2-nd floor (the Library).

7. FINANCING

All expenses for the business trip of the participants (travel, meals, daily allowance, accommodation during the competition) shall be borne by sending organizations. Accommodation and meals of foreign participants shall be provided pursuant to an agreement with the Kazakhstan Chess Federation.

8. AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony for the competition winners and runners-up shall be conducted by Kazakhstan Chess Federation and the Central Board of the Kazakhstan Deaf Society.

Winners among men and women competitions are receiving money prize and diplomas of the Central Board of the Kazakhstan Deaf Society, medals of Kazakhstan Chess Federation, while runners-up shall be granted with diplomas and medals of respective degrees, valuable gifts of Kazakhstan Chess Federation and the Central Board of the Kazakhstan Deaf Society.

9. APPLICATIONS
